Between narcissism and entitlement: Self-enhancement in a cross-cultural perspective

On behalf of the scientific and organizing committee we are pleased to announce the international conference 'Between narcissism and entitlement: Self-enhancement in a cross-cultural perspective'. The conference will take place from 4th of April until the 6th of April 2018, at Cardinal Stefan Wyszynski University in Warsaw, Poland.

Self-enhancement is a very important topic in different fields of psychology, including (but not limited to) social psychology and personality psychology. It can be perceived as the universal human characteristic, which nonetheless shows interesting cross-cultural differences. Self-enhancement can be pictured as an 'umbrella term', related, among others, to such phenomena as self-esteem, narcissism, self-serving attribution bias, entitlement and so on. There are interesting differences between cultures in understanding and evaluating self-enhancement, which make this topic especially valid for cross-cultural research.

The main goal of the conference is to facilitate a discussion on studying self-enhancement in different cultures, but from cross-cultural perspective as well. We aim to integrate researchers originating from different fields of psychology (e.g., social, personality, developmental, cognitive) and from different cultural background.

We hope that one of the results of the conference will be a widespread research on self-enhancement conducted in a cross-cultural context. To this end, we propose also pre-conference workshops on methodological and statistical issues related to cross-cultural research.

We invite all submissions focusing on broadly defined self-enhancement issues (and ego-quieting in opposition) with referring to specific cultural as well as broad cross-cultural context, including: narcissism, entitlement and Dark Triad. As a part of the conference we aim to present a summary of the Cross-Cultural Self-Enhancement Project carried out in over 50 countries.
